Conditions of Use of the Library and Archive Collections

Archive collections include rare and unique materials. To safeguard these valuable materials researchers are requested to observe the Rules for the Use of Archive Collections.

- Materials are retrieved by the staff for use in the library, one box or vertical file folder at a time.
- **Pens or similar writing materials may not be used.** Pencils and computers may be use to take notes.
- Materials must be handled with care. Cotton gloves are provided for touching photographic prints and negatives. Do not lean on large items or place paper or notepads on top of documents while taking notes.
- Researchers must **ask permission before photocopying** any material in archive collections. Fragile or damaged materials cannot be copied.
- Documents in the library and archive collections have been arranged in an order that must be maintained. **Maintain the existing order of material within each folder and box.**
- The Library reserves the right to limit the use of materials that are not arranged or in the process of being arranged.

Researchers shall assume full responsibility for conforming to the laws regarding copyright, libel, and literary property rights that may be involved in the use of materials obtained from the New Mexico Museum of Art must be credited: “New Mexico Museum of Art Library and Archives” as the source of cited materials.

We appreciate your cooperation to ensure that these collections will be available for future researchers.
