FOREWORD

The Graphic Arts Annual of the Museum of New Mexico Art Gallery is open to all New Mexico "graphic artists" -- printmakers, illustrators and photographers. All media in prints, drawing and photography are eligible for entry. Each artist may enter two works and all entries are exhibited.

A show of three to four dozen leading works is selected from the exhibition each year for circulation to other art centers of the state. The 35 works selected from the current Annual for this traveling exhibition are indicated with asterisks in the catalog list.

Honor Citations for outstanding work in each of four categories -- color print, black and white print, photography, and drawing -- are made each year by a Committee on Awards, composed of three or four leading New Mexico artists of the graphic arts field. The entries of the committee members themselves are withheld from judging and are considered ineligible for purchase awards.
